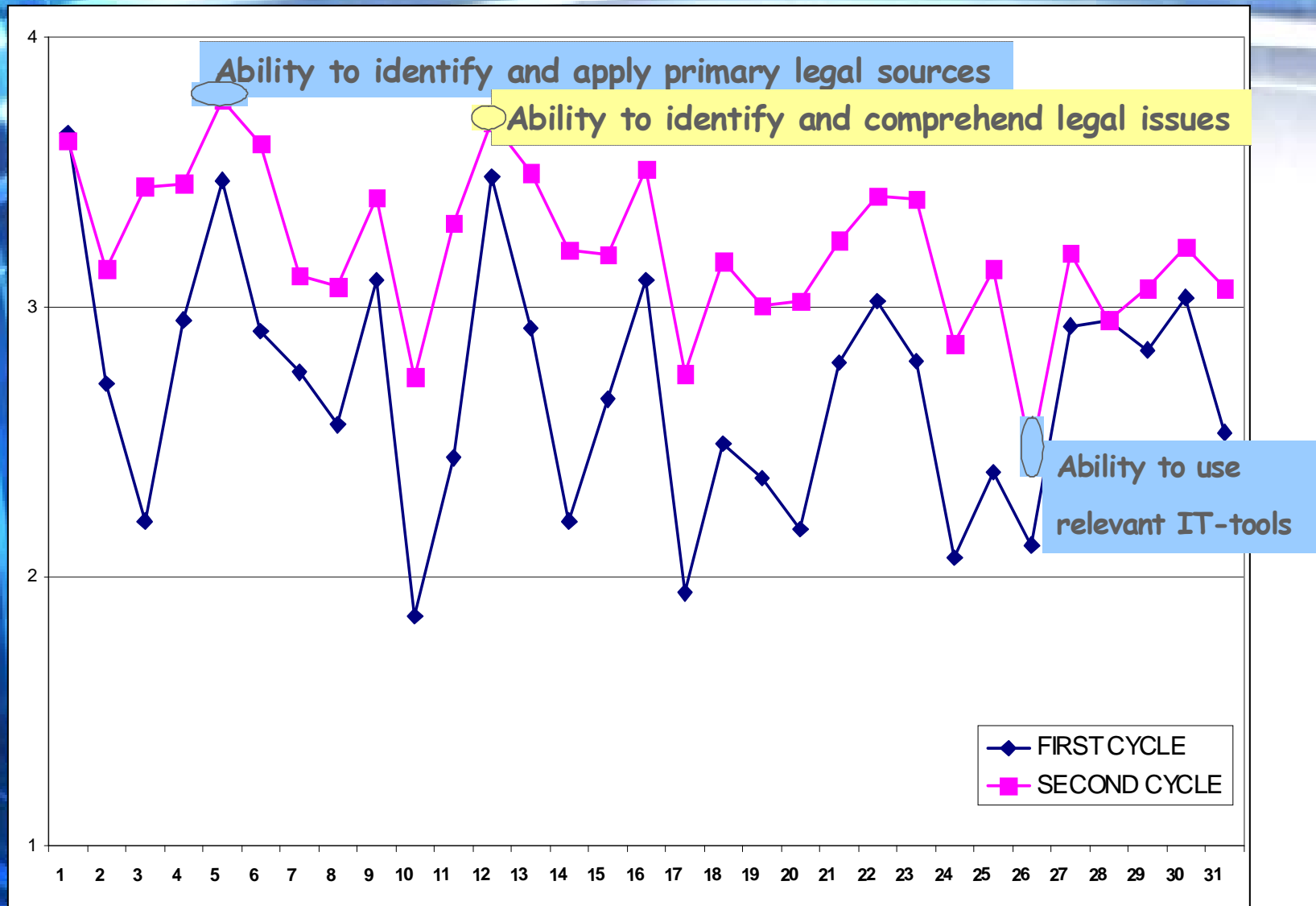
Qualification frameworks
